

## **Supplies Checklist**

**The Camp Host at Carter Creek will provide these supplies if needed at no extra cost:**

- Individually-wrapped Bar Soap
- Trash bags
- Firewood (If available)
- Toilet Paper for Camp Trailers
- Toilet Paper in the Bath House

**Here are some supplies you may want to bring that are NOT provided by the camp host:**

- Bug Repellant
- Matches/Lighter/Fire Starters
- Charcoal
- Sunscreen
- Lantern/Flashlight
- Batteries
- Compass/Whistle
- Misc. Tools
- Tissues
- Fishing License (Required for anglers 12 years old and above)
- First aid kit
- Sunglasses
- Boots (especially if you are planning on riding ATV's or Hiking)
- Cooking Items
- Pots and Pans, Aluminum Foil, Measuring Cups, Pam Spray, Containers for Food, Spatulas, Knives, Spoons, Tongs, Can/Bottle Opener, Oven Mitts, Mixing Bowls, Cutting Board, Ziploc Bags, Peeler, Seasonings, Sugar, Condiments
- Ice
- Bath Towels and Wash Clothes
- Hygiene Products
- Toothbrushes, Toothpaste, Shampoo/Conditioner, Body Wash, Comb/Brush, Shower Shoes, Deodorant, Feminine Products, Medications
- Cleaning Items (i.e. Rags, Scrubbing Pads, Dish Soap, Paper Towels and Moist Wipes)
- Personal Linens, Bedding and Pillows (most people use sleeping bags on the beds)
- Air Mattress, Air Pump
- Plates, Cups, Bowls and Silverware (most people bring paper products/plastic utensils)
- If Tent Camping; Tarp, Extra Stakes, Hammer
- Clothing - Light/Heavy Jacket, Rain Gear, Extra Day of Clothes
